Call to Worship: *Psalm* 13:6 – I will sing to the LORD, because he has dealt bountifully with me.

Heidelberg Catechism: Lord's Day 4 (pages 9-10)

- Q. But doesn't God do man an injustice by requiring in His law what man is unable to do?
 - A. No, God created man with the ability to keep the law. Man, however, tempted by the devil, in reckless disobedience, robbed himself and all his descendants of these gifts.
- Q. Will God permit such disobedience and rebellion to go unpunished?
 - A. Certainly not. He is terribly angry about the sin we are born with as well as the sins we personally commit. As a just judge He punishes them now and in eternity. He has declared: "Cursed be everyone who does not abide by all things written in the book of the law, and do them."
- Q. But isn't God also merciful?
 - A. God is certainly merciful, but He is also just. His justice demands that sin, committed against His supreme majesty, be punished with the supreme penalty eternal punishment of body and soul.

*Old Testament Lesson: Psalm 1

- ¹Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stands in the path of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful;
- ² But his delight is in the law of the LORD, and in His law he meditates day and night.
- ³ He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaf also shall not wither; and whatever he does shall prosper.
- ⁴ The ungodly are not so, but are like the chaff which the wind drives away.
- ⁵Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous.

- ⁶ For the LORD knows the way of the righteous, but the way of the ungodly shall perish.
- *Gospel Lesson: Romans 1:18-24
- ¹⁸ For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness,
- ¹⁹ because what may be known of God is manifest in them, for God has shown it to them.
- For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse,
- ²¹ because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened.
- ²² Professing to be wise, they became fools,
- ²³ and changed the glory of the incorruptible God into an image made like corruptible man—and birds and four-footed animals and creeping things.
- ²⁴ Therefore God also gave them up to uncleanness, in the lusts of their hearts, to dishonor their bodies among themselves.
