Heidelberg Catechism: Lord's Day 8 (page 12)

Q. How are these articles divided?

A. Into three parts: God the Father and our creation; God the Son and our deliverance; God the Holy Spirit and our sanctification.

Q. Since there is but one God, why do you speak of three: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit?

A. Because that is how God has revealed Himself in His Word:

these three distinct persons are one, true, eternal God. ***Hymn of Adoration**: 352 *"Blessed Be the Name"*

Call to Confession: 2 *Chronicles 30:9b* – "For the Lord your God is gracious and merciful, and will not turn His face from you if you return to

Him."
